The City of Moultrie, Georgia, will receive SEALED PROPOSALS FOR 26th Avenue SE Box Culvert until 2:00 PM, Tuesday, April 8, 2025, at the Downtown Moultrie Welcome Center, 31 East Central Ave., Moultrie, Georgia, at which time the proposals shall be publicly opened and read.

THE WORK TO BE DONE consists of furnishing all labor, tools, materials and equipment necessary to demolish existing storm drain culverts and rebuild new box culvert in place on 26th Avenue SE. More specifically, the work consist of removing and disposal of four existing CMP, grading, road basing, milling, asphalt paving, guardrails, striping and all other appurtenances necessary to complete the project in accordance to the specifications and construction drawings.

***NOTICE: A MANDATORY Pre-Bid Conference for this project will be held at 2:00 PM, local time, Tuesday, March 25, 2025, at the Downtown Moultrie Welcome Center, 31 East Central Ave., Moultrie, Georgia. Representatives of owner and engineer will be present to discuss the project. Bidders are required to attend and participate in the conference. Engineer will transmit to all prospective bidders of record such addenda as engineer considers necessary in response to questions arising at the conference. Companies, individuals, and entities that fail to attend the mandatory pre-bid conference shall not be allowed to submit a bid for the project.
